Referral to the Neurological Rehabilitation Program

If you think you would benefit from the Neurological Rehabilitation Program we will require a referral from your General Practitioner or treating Specialist.

Once we receive a referral our Consultant Physicians may elect to assess you in our specialist 'NeuroRehab Clinic' to determine which Rehabilitation Program best suits your needs.

Fees and Charges

In most cases the fee is covered by the health insurer, however you should check with your fund if you have any additional charges specific to your health policy. We also cater for full fee paying patients who do not have private health insurance.




